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Example Workshop Schedule

1. Introduction	Objectives of the day and using theatrical skills to enhance presentations.
2. Presentation 1	Pre-prepared 2 minutes “what is my role in my organisation?”
3. Presenting as Dialogue - Part I	“My speaking doesn’t automatically imply your listening” - understanding that presenting is a dialogue not a monologue. Using space, energy and body to create engagement.
4. Managing Nerves	Fight, flight or freeze: the physiology of stress. Troubleshooting - on the day.
5. Inviting Being Seen	Inviting Being Seen. Three circles of energy.
BREAK - Morning tea	
6. Voice	Breath, Sound and Rhythm. Telling the Story of your voice.
7. Insight and Inspiration	MTC actor in conversation.
BREAK - Lunch	
8. Warm up	Get the blood flowing after lunch!
9. Presenting as Dialogue - Part II	Why do we present in person? Identifying what you want. - Factual objectives: What do I want them to do? - Emotional objectives: What do I want them to feel? Authenticity.
10. Identifying your Audience	What does the audience want from you? Preparation for future presentations - researching your audience.
BREAK - Afternoon tea	
11. Presentation 2 (On Southbank Theatre stage)	Coaching. Each person presents their reworked 2 minute presentation focusing on one skill element from the day. Feedback on the day.
