CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN 6

COMPLETION OF MAJOR TRAM WORKS

Major tram works, including the construction of a new central island tram stop on Sturt Street, the installation of new tram poles and tracks, and the creation of a new planted section of track was completed on Sunday 30 September. Tram services along Route 1 resumed operation on Monday 1 October 2018.

Thank you for your patience during these works.

Sturt street

Sturt Street has now re-opened to traffic for north-south vehicle movement, allowing the Grant Street detour to again function for access to the Arts Centre Melbourne carpark.



Trams

The Route 1 tram resumed operation on Monday 1 October 2018. The new central island tram stop is numbered as 'Stop 17'.



Pedestrians

Three sides of the Sturt Street and Southbank Boulevard intersection have been re-opened. The crossing on the eastern side of the intersection will re-open in November.



Vehicles

New traffic lights will be installed in the coming weeks. Until then, traffic controllers will continue to assist with the safe operation of this intersection.

Over the course of the coming months, vehicle access to the section of Southbank Boulevard between St Kilda Road and Sturt Street will reopen as construction works in this work area are completed.

WHAT'S NEXT?

During the week commencing 15 October 2018, the works compound which is currently located in Dodds Street, will be relocated. The compound will move to a new location near the corner of Southbank Boulevard and Moore Street, in front of the ABC Southbank Centre.

Moving the compound will allow work to be completed in the section of Southbank Boulevard and Dodds Street which is currently closed to traffic between St Kilda Road and Sturt Street.


SITE COMPOUND MOVE
