MTC Indigenous Scholarship Program 2018

What is it?

Melbourne Theatre Company, in partnership with the Wilin Centre for Indigenous Arts and Cultural Development, is offering a one-of-a-kind learning opportunity to young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people interested in a career in the performing arts.

The program is made up of a series of workshops that explore performance skills, writing for the stage, technical and design aspects of creating a production and how to develop a marketing campaign. We then end with a short performance by the group at Southbank Theatre for family and friends.

Participants will also see a variety of live performances including comedy, dance, musical and theatre shows and have the opportunity to meet a range of industry professionals (actors, writers, directors and designers) to learn more about potential career pathways.

Program participants will be supported by Indigenous teaching artists, mentors and the Wilin Centre where they can receive cultural support and assistance in making an application to the Victorian College of the Arts, The University of Melbourne, if they wish to explore further study.

When and where?

Who can apply?

Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people aged between 17 - 22.

Interstate applicants are welcome to apply, however priority will be given to Victorian residents.

Places are limited and you must be able to attend all three weeks.

Accommodation and travel

Accommodation in a shared apartment (with private bedrooms) can be provided for a limited number of regional participants if they do not have family to stay with in Melbourne. Chaperone support can be provided at the accommodation for those under 18.

Travel for regional participants can also be provided (bus/train).

Meals

Lunch each day during the three weeks of the program will be provided to participants.

Personal spending money will be required to cover other meals or activities that are not a part of the program. We recommend participants have access to a minimum of \$40 per day (\$200 for the week).
